- Rules:
1. Competitors are required to have a current year Bracebridge Agricultural Society membership.
 2. Weight Scales to be used. All light teams subject to weigh-in.
 - (a) Combined weight not to exceed 3400 lbs.
 - (b) Scales open at 9:00 am
 3. No horse may compete in more than one drawing class.
 4. No Drugs allowed.
 5. Pull to be 15 feet - 2 pulls
 6. The Horse Pull will be run under the Central Canadian Horse Pulling Association rules.
 7. All drivers/owners must carry liability insurance and provide policy information at time of registration.

- Rules:
1. Formal Attire is REQUIRED for ALL RIDERS
 2. Horses and Ponies: MANE and TAIL Braids REQUIRED
 3. ALL RIDERS must have 2019 OEF memberships
 4. Entry Fees must be paid before the start of the event
 5. All horse and rider combinations may only enter one (1) division height. However, a rider may ride two (2) different horses in the same division.
 6. The derby consists of two (2) rounds. The first round is the Classic Round, and will be judged on quality, movement, jumping style, manners and way of going, with pace and brilliance rewarded. The second round is the Handy Hunter Round, judged similarly to the Classic Round, bonus points will be rewarded on handy track and high options. Call back to the Handy Round will be the top twelve (12) Classic Round scores.
 7. A second refusal to jump will cause elimination.
 8. No Jumps on course will be allowed to be jumped until the first course, the ring will be open to hacking prior to the start to allow Horse and Rider to determine track and look at all the jumps. Warm up jumps will be available in warm up ring.
 9. Course Walks will be scheduled prior to the start of each division.
 10. Small, Medium, and Large pony divisions will be judged on one card.

Registration: Registration will be accepted the day of the show at the Horse Show booth at the main ring or advance registration by email to sagecreekfarm@hotmail.com. Registration begins at 9:30 am. Children's classes begin at 10:00am. Open to English and Western riders.

Competitors bringing horse trailers are asked to the greatest extent possible to park to the east side of the ring (closest to Hwy#11). No horses are permitted on the midway side of the ring.

- Rules:
1. All prize money will be paid to the rider and sent by mail in October.
 2. Proper attire is requested – long pants, shirts, hats, no shorts or tank tops.
 3. Junior riders are any rider 18 years of age or younger. Junior riders may compete in Open classes.
 4. Senior riders are any rider 19 years of age and older.
 5. All competitors 18 years of age and under must wear a correctly fastened (ASTM/SEI) approved helmet while mounted.
 6. Competitors are required to have a current Bracebridge Agricultural Society Membership for insurance purposes on the fairgrounds. Cards are available at the Fair Office prior to showing.
 7. No horse or pony shall be ridden faster than a walk, other than in the horse ring, and must be kept under control at all times, under penalty of dismissal.
 8. All riders must carry liability insurance and provide policy information at time of registration. While every precaution is taken, neither the Bracebridge Agricultural Society nor officials are responsible for any loss, damage or injury to property, animals or persons.
 9. There will be no use of the show ring for practice or orientation prior to the competition. Warm-up for afternoon games will be during and after the lunch break.
 10. Bits must be used respectfully – no undue force applied. No spurs allowed in any games or in the Saddle Up Challenge.
 11. Junior riders may carry a crop to encourage movement but excessive use will not be allowed.
 12. A Ring Steward is on-site to oversee rules and safety issues.

In case of show cancellation due to inclement weather, no premium or compensation will be paid.
