Sections:

1. Wood carving - realistic, any wildlife subject including songbird
2. Wood carving - any subject **NEW!**
3. Wood chipping **NEW!**
4. Constructed wooden item (e.g., model, jewellery box, game board, etc.)
5. Cane or walking stick – carved or decorated – no longer than 24"
6. Garden Item (e.g., sign, bird house or feeder, wind chimes, etc.)
7. Sculpture - any subject and medium (e.g., wood, clay, metal, etc.)
8. Pyrographic art - design or picture on any surface or object
9. Item made from recycled material - any medium
10. Doll outfit displayed on doll
11. Door decoration, wreath or table centrepiece
12. Painting on found object - any material
13. Scrapbooking - 1 page – no larger than 12" x 12"
14. Greeting or note card - displayed in plastic envelope
15. Bookmark – any medium
16. Pressed flower craft in plastic sheath or frame
17. Jewellery - any medium - up to a three-piece combination
18. Decorate 3 eggs – any variety – to in some way commemorate the 150 years of the history of Canada and our own Bracebridge fair – display eggs together in an appropriate container
