3. Entry Fee: \$1.50 per exhibit and must accompany entry form payable to the Bracebridge Agricultural Society. Entries not paid will not be judged.
4. Entries are limited to three (3) animals per section. (Sr.B, Sr.D, Int.B, Int.D, Jr.B, Jr.D including Meat Pen and Doe & Litter Classes). Class must have twelve (12) animals by three (3) exhibitors to be split by colour and grouping. To maximum of 350 entries.
