4. Honey, dark - 375 ml. (500 gm) glass cylinder bottle
5. Honey, comb - one (1) section, approx. 10 cm x 10 cm

CLASS 71 EGGS

Sections: 1. One Dozen Chicken Eggs - white shell
2. One Dozen Hen's Eggs - brown shell
3. Half Dozen Eggs - any fowl but chicken
4. One Dozen Chicken Eggs – other than white or brown shell
5. Exotic fowl eggs, maximum 6
