Registration: Registration will be accepted the day of the show at the Horse Show Booth, main Ring. Registration will close three classes ahead.

Booth opens at 7:30 am. First competitors to be in place by 9:30 am.
Dogs are not permitted on the fairgrounds.

- Rules:**
1. **All exhibitors must provide proof of OEF membership.**
 2. All prize money will be paid to the rider, and sent by mail in October.
 3. Trophies and High Point prizes will be awarded at the Awards banquet.
 4. Junior Riders are any rider 18 years of age or younger. Junior riders may also compete in Open classes.
 5. Senior Riders are any rider 19 years of age and older.
 6. Novice Division is any age riders with less than 2 years show experience and/or green horses. Riders may not participate in any other division.
 7. Lead-line riders must be 3 – 10 years of age. Riders may not participate in any other division.
 8. Proper attire and tack is required for all classes.
 9. All riders must wear a correctly fastened (ASTM/SEI) approved helmet while mounted.
 10. Equine Canada Rules apply.
 11. Entrants are required to have a current year Bracebridge Agricultural Society membership. Cards are available at the Fair Office prior to showing for a \$5 fee.
 12. No horse or pony shall be ridden faster than a walk, other than in the Ring, and must be kept under control at all times, under penalty of dismissal.
 13. No horse or pony shall be ridden anywhere other than in the ring, the warm up area or on the East side of the ring.
 14. In the event of a fall, all riders must halt their horse and await the judge's signal for the continuation of the class.
 15. Ponies - Fence height adjustments will not be made for ponies.

Novice Division: \$10.00 per class or \$25.00 for all classes
Junior Division: \$10.00 per class or \$35.00 for all classes
Senior Division: \$10.00 per class or \$35.00 for all classes
