Sections:

- 1. Wood carving - realistic, any wildlife subject including birds and fowl
 - 2. Wood carving - any subject, maximum 24"
 - 3. Constructed wooden item (e.g., model, jewellery box, game board, etc.)
 - 4. Garden Item (e.g., sign, bird house or feeder, wind chimes, etc.)
 - 5. Wood burning / pyrographic art - design or picture on any surface or object
 - 6. Item made from recycled material - any medium
 - 7. Door decoration, wreath or table centrepiece
 - 8. Scrapbooking - 1 page – no larger than 12" x 12"
 - 9. Greeting or note card - displayed in plastic envelope
 - 10. Bookmark – any medium
 - 11. Jewellery - any medium - up to a three-piece combination
 - 12. Sculpture – any subject and medium (clay, wood, metal, etc.)
 - 13. Mixed media art, using any medium, max. size 16" x 16"
 - 14. Paper sculpture or Origami
 - 15. String art creation – max. size 16" x 16"
 - 16. Table centrepiece based on theme of Thanksgiving or Halloween – any medium
