Rules & Regulations:

1. All floral entries must be grown by the exhibitor with the exception of arrangements.
2. Houseplants **must** be grown in 12" pots or less.
3. Open bottom pots **must** be contained.
4. Exhibitors must own houseplants for at least three (3) months prior to the fair.
5. A.O.K. - means any other kind
A.O.V. - means any other variety
A.O.C. - means any other colour
6. Attach Entry Tag securely with string or elastic (no tape).
7. Please note that all judges are accredited and do not enter at the Bracebridge fair.
